

## Fellowship in Pediatric Urology, BC Children's Hospital, Department of Urologic Sciences, University of British Columbia Vancouver, BC, Canada



The Division of Pediatric Urology is accepting applications for a one-year clinical fellowship at British Columbia Children's Hospital starting July 1st, 2017. BC Children's Hospital is the only tertiary pediatric centre in the province of British Columbia, serving a population of 4.7 million. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to work with three fellowship-trained pediatric urologists who perform over 600 surgeries per year and see 5500 patients annually in the outpatient clinics. The fellowship program encompasses training in all aspects of pediatric urological surgeries, including complex urinary reconstruction, renal transplant, MIS and robotics. Outpatient urology and multidisciplinary clinics ensure high levels of exposure to a wide range of pathologies, such as disorders of sexual differentiation and neurogenic bladder.

UBC has a fully accredited Urology Residency Program. Pediatric Urology Fellows will be expected to share clinical duties with and teach UBC Urology residents and undergraduate medical students. The successful applicant is expected to be actively involved in clinical research. Didactic teaching in clinical research through the UBC School of Public Health is available for interested candidates. Research support, such as a full-time research coordinator, statistical and administrative assistance, will be provided by Division of Urology and Child and Family Research Institute.

Completion of an accredited Urology residency and eligibility for licensure by The College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia are required.
