

Kidney Transplant/ Advanced MIS Fellowship



We are currently accepting applications for the 2019-2020 Royal College Accredited fellowship in kidney transplantation and advanced MIS urology. This is a 1- or 2-year program encompassing all surgical

(living and deceased donation, recipient allograft placement, transplant reconstruction) and medical aspects of kidney transplantation. Upon completion of training the candidate will earn an Area of Focused Competence certification in Solid Organ Transplantation — Kidney Transplant Surgery from the RCPSC. The fellow will work intimately with a team of 4 surgeons and 6 transplant nephrologists during their training. High volume exposure to PCNL, URS, ESWL, advanced laparoscopic procedures (donor nephrectomy, pyeloplasty, partial nephrectomy, radical nephrectomy, and adrenalectomy) and robotics is commensurate with the transplant aspect of the program. Protected time for research is inclusive with the potential of earning a Master's degree for those candidates interested in the 2nd year.
