



Fellowship in Urologic Oncology:

The fellowship is designed to prepare surgical leaders in academic Urologic Oncology. We have 4 fellowship-trained urologic oncologists involved in the program with broad experiences. This will involve training in minimally invasive, robotic, cryotherapy and open oncology surgeries. Calgary is a very high-volume urology centre that will allow ample clinical and surgical experiences. Our faculty also has extensive basic science and clinical research and there is an opportunity for clinical and/or basic science research collborations. The program can be 1 or 2 years starting in July 2018.

Program candidate must have taken their Board Exam or comparable examinations.
