

COMMUNITY UROLOGIC SURGEON WINNIPEG REGIONAL HEALTH AUTHORITY SURGERY PROGRAM

The Winnipeg Regional Health Authority Surgery Program invites applications for a Community Urologic Surgeon position.

This position encompasses inpatient and ambulatory patient care responsibility with full participation in Community Urology Call and participation in teaching and mentoring Urology Residents.

Candidate must have specialty qualifications in Urology and be eligible for registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. Certification in Urologic Surgery by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada is preferred.

Candidate must be willing and able to assess and provide treatment for patients with a wide assortment of general urologic conditions and perform basic urological procedures including laser lithotripsy, radical prostatectomy and laparoscopic nephrectomy.

Candidate must be able to work collaboratively in a team environment and be willing to access WRHA resources at multiple sites.

The position is community based and remuneration is on a fee-for-service basis. The start date for the position is negotiable.

Applications are encouraged from qualified women and men including members of visible minorities, Aboriginal peoples and persons with disabilities. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however Canadians and permanent residents will be given priority.
