

Urologist, Saanich Peninsula, Vancouver Island

The Saanich Peninsula Hospital (SPH) within the Vancouver Island Health Authority is recruiting a community-based urologist to replace a retiring urologist on the Saanich Peninsula.

Saanich Peninsula Hospital is a family practice centered hospital, with strong community support and a medical staff that has a long history of supporting 'one of' specialists in a variety of specialties. Located 30 minutes from two tertiary hospitals in Victoria, SPH is a 59-bed hospital with 2 ORs (no ICU) and a busy 24/7 ER, plus a148 bed extended care facility. The operative program consists of in-patient (short-stay) and day care, made up of General Urology procedures for ASA 1 / 2 patients plus in-hospital cystoscopy. A new OR was completed in September and equipment purchases commensurate with the nature of the practice will be negotiated. Appropriate special interest will be supported where feasible.

You hold FRCSC in Urology and will assume an established practice on the Peninsula and provide paid on-call services to SPH. Your urology practice will support 35 local family physicians with additional increasing referrals from Victoria and neighbouring Gulf Islands. The UBC Island Medical Program provides opportunity for academic affiliation and participation in teaching of medical students and residents.

Saanich Peninsula is a beautiful part of Vancouver Island, made up of a small city (Sidney) and 2 small communities (Saanichton & Brentwood Bay) plus the surrounding semi-rural countryside and only a 30-minute drive from all the amenities of Victoria.
