Academic Paediatric Urologic Surgeon, Department of Surgery

The Divisions of Urology and Paediatric Surgery, Department of Surgery, Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry at Western University are seeking a full-time clinical academic paediatric urologic surgeon at the rank of Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor to join the current pediatric urologist.

The Divisions of Urology and Paediatric Surgery are affiliated with Children's Hospital at London Health Sciences Centre and St. Joseph's Health Care London. Children's Hospital is the only tertiary care centre between Toronto and Winnipeg, serving a population of over 500,000 children and youth. The successful applicant will have the opportunity to practice the full breadth of pediatric urology including robotics. The successful candidate will be expected to participate in the Divisions' academic and educational initiatives and there is ample opportunity to develop his/her research interests. The individual will work in a highly collaborative environment with clinicians and researchers in several Faculties and Departments. An Alternate Funding Plan (AFP) has been approved by the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care to support the recruitment.

Qualified candidates must have completed an accredited urologic surgery training program from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (or equivalent), a minimum of 2 years of pediatric urology fellowship training and be eligible for licensure in the Province of Ontario.

London is Canada's 10th largest city with a population of 400,000, a catchment area of 2 million, and is situated in southwestern Ontario between Toronto and Detroit. London is a safe, affordable, and diverse city and its numerous parks, trails, recreational, cultural and sporting opportunities make it an attractive place to live. The University of Western Ontario is a research-intensive university with full-time enrolment of about 34,000 students with a full range of academic and professional programs. The Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry (Schulich) provides an outstanding educational experience within a research intensive environment where tomorrow's physicians, dentists and health researchers learn to be socially responsible leaders in the advancement of human health. The Urology Residency program is fully accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and trainees continuously rotate through the pediatric urology service.
