ACADEMIC UROLOGIST: NS – The Department of Urology at Dalhousie University is seeking an academic urologist with subspecialty training in oncology. This position will be a Continuing Appointment with Annual Academic Career Development and will include an appointment at appropriate academic rank in the Faculty of Medicine. In addition to adult patient care, responsibilities will include teaching and research commitments. The successful candidate will join an established Department of Urology with strong interests in clinical and basic research. Candidates must hold FRCSC qualification in Urology or equivalent and must have completed satisfactory fellowship training. Candidates will have demonstrated experience in research, teaching and administration. Dalhousie University is an employment equity/affirmative action employer. The University encourages applications from qualified Aboriginal peoples, persons with a disability, racially visible persons and women. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority.
