

UROLOGIST SURGERY PROGRAM WINNIPEG REGIONAL HEALTH AUTHORITY

The Winnipeg Regional Health Authority Surgery Program invites applications for an Urologist commencing July 1st, 2018 or sooner. This position will join a group of 19 Academic and Community Urologists in the Regional Urology Section.

The position encompasses inpatient and ambulatory patient care responsibilities. Operative resources will be primarily at Victoria General Hospital and Grace General Hospital. Call requirements are based out of these two hospitals and will be divided proportionally amongst group members. The Surgeon is expected to participate in the M&M, quality assurance, and Journal Club rounds, organized by the Urology section. Remuneration is derived from Fee for Service income.

Candidates must have specialty qualifications in Urology in the country of current practice, and must be eligible for registration with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba. Certification in Urology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada is preferred.
