Candidates must hold an MD plus FRCSC qualification in Urology, or equivalent qualifications, and must have completed a fellowship in andrology and male infertility. Competence in infertility microsurgery, Peyronie's and penile prosthetic surgery, and Holmium or Thulium laser enucleation of the prostate is required. The successful candidate will lead a comprehensive Men's Health Clinic, combining clinical, research, and educational activities to meet the needs of the Department and community.

This position will hold a Continuing Appointment with Annual Academic Career Development at the appropriate academic rank within the Faculty of Medicine. In addition to patient care, responsibilities will include teaching, research and administration. Commitment to building an academic career with a research focus is expected. Candidates will have a proven and ongoing research track record within the past 3 years and will be expected to dedicate at least 0.2 FTE to research activity. Candidates must demonstrate an interest and commitment to medical education and be expected to assume administrative positions of leadership within the Department.
