

Associate Urologist (2 Positions)
Trillium Health Partners - Surgery Program

The Division of Urology, Trillium Health Partners Health Partners (THP), members of the Department of Surgery at the University of Toronto invite applications for 1.5 FTE Associate Urologic Surgeons. The successful applicants will be based primarily at Mississauga Hospital site (1.0 FTE) and the Credit Valley Hospital site (0.5 FTE) of THP.

THP is one of the largest providers of urology care in Ontario. As a major provider THP's goal is to continue to advance our urology program and are seeking two urologic surgeons, to provide comprehensive Urologic care to our community. Although not a prerequisite, candidates with recognized fellowship training who bring specific expertise and focus to the program are preferred.

THP's Urology Division consists of 8 Urology Surgeons and provides service to the City of Mississauga and surrounding communities. We provide specialized care in all domains of urologic care and are affiliated with University of Toronto and specifically the Mississauga Academy of Medicine.

The role description for the successful applicants will include: providing comprehensive urologic care to the community, supporting the delivery of unplanned care, contributing to medical education, and assuming leadership roles within the organization.

For the 0.5 FTE role at Credit Valley Hospital site, fellowship training in Urological Oncology is strongly preferred. Proficiency in Robotic Assisted Surgery, familiarity with Medical Oncologic management of advanced Prostate Cancer, and other genitourinary cancers would be an asset. For the 1.0 FTE role at Mississauga Hospital site, comprehensive urologic skill set with proficiency in open cases would be an asset and while fellowship training is not required, it will be preferred.

Remuneration will be on a fee-for-service basis through billings submitted by the physicians to Ontario Health Insurance Plan. The successful candidates will care for surgical inpatients and outpatients, and participate in the on-call rotation supporting Trillium Health Partners.

Applicants must hold an MD or equivalent with completed training in Urology and must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. The successful candidates must have obtained the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Fellowship in Urology Surgery or equivalent. These positions will be recruited at a level dependent upon the qualifications of the successful candidates, and proven leadership skills will be highly valuable.

The application process will remain open until the positions are filled (application deadline is February 28, 2022).
