



Community Urologist Dartmouth General Hospital Nova Scotia Health

The Department of Urology at Dalhousie University and Nova Scotia Health are seeking to hire a full time Urologist. This position will have its clinical base at the Dartmouth General Hospital (DGH) within the Halifax Regional Municipality, Nova Scotia. DGH is a very active community hospital, with 110 inpatient beds (to increase to 160), 8 operating rooms, and 41,000 emergency vists per year.

The successful candidate will join one other Urologist at DGH, and 9 adult Urologists at the QE2 Health Sciences Centre. He/she/they will participate in the Acute Care Surgery service at DGH and take a full share of 1 in 3 Urology call. He/she/they will also have operating and admitting privleges at the QE2, and consulting privleges at all associated hospitals in the Central Zone of NSH, as well as the IWK. He/she/they will receive a limited term appointment with Dalhousie University, Faculty of Medicine, appropriate to their qualifications.

Candidates must hold FRCSC qualification in Urology or equivalent. All qualified candidates are encouraged to apply; however, Canadian citizens and permanent residents will be given priority. A defined clinical interest compatible with the needs and strategic direction of the DGH site is preferred, with general urology services being the priority. Subspecialty fellowship training is not necessary but is an asset. Remuneration is based on fee for service billing. Candidates will have demonstrated experience in research, teaching and administration. A close and active relationship with the Department of Urology at Dalhousie University is expected of the successful candidate, with expectations of participating in research, education, and administrative roles at DGH and through Dalhousie University. Additional stipend funding will be made available to support additional academic and administrative activities.

The Department of Urology is committed to fostering a collegial culture grounded in diversity and inclusiveness. It encourages applications from Aboriginal people, persons with a disability, racially visible persons, women, and all candidates who would contribute to the diversity of our community.
