## DR. DONALD C. STEELE

The CUA community was saddened to learn of the passing of Dr. Donald Steele, who died on April 22, 2022, at the age of 92. He is survived by his wife of 65 years, Shirley, his children Mark (Teresa) and Gwendolyn (Rick), grandchildren Graham, Julia (Sean), Anthony, and Sarah, and his great-granddaughter Elise.

After graduating from the University of Toronto School of Medicine and completing his surgical training at Toronto Western Hospital, Dr. Steele set up his practice in his hometown of St. Catharines, ON, where he practiced for his entire career. He was also the co-founder of

the St. Catharines Urological Clinic and a past-President of the Buffalo Urological Society.

In addition to his accomplishments in urology, Dr. Steele had many other interests.
