


KELOWNA, BRITISH COLUMBIA

The Division of Urology, Department of Surgery at Kelowna General Hospital is accepting applications for a full-time urologist position. Applicants must hold an MD degree and be eligible for registration and licensure to practice medicine in British Columbia, be a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (Urology), have Canadian Medical Protective Association (CMPA) coverage and be licensed with the College of Physicians of BC (CPSBC). The successful candidate will also have completed a specialized fellowship in urology.

The successful candidate will be expected to equivalently share resources (i.e. operative time, cystoscopy, and ambulatory care) and responsibilities (i.e. 1-in-4 call coverage for Kelowna and surrounding area and administration of educational programs and relevant department committees) with three other urologists with subspecialty training in endourology, uro-oncology and reconstructive urology. Subspecialty training in pediatrics and/or infertility would be preferred. Compensation is fee-for-service.
