In addition to his remarkable professional accomplishments and his dedication to improving the lives of patients with urologic disease and kidney cancer, our community will miss his gregarious and upbeat personality, as well as his wonderful sense of humour.

Anil's legacy will certainly live on through the countless patients he helped, as well as the colleagues he mentored and inspired. He will be deeply missed by all who knew him.
