



Advanced MIS Endourology Fellowship / Kidney Transplant

We are currently accepting applications for the combined MIS, endourology and Royal College Accredited fellowship in kidney transplantation. This is a 1- or 2-year program with high volume exposure to PCNL, URS, ESWL, and advanced laparoscopic and robotic procedures (donor nephrectomy, prostatectomy, pyeloplasty, partial nephrectomy, nephroureterectomy, radical nephrectomy, and adrenalectomy). Our PCNL practice includes supine, prone, mini, and ultrasound access. For those pursuing an Area of Focused Competence certification in Solid Organ Transplantation – Kidney Transplant Surgery from the RCPSC, we provide experience in all surgical (living and deceased donation, recipient allograft placement, transplant reconstruction) and medical aspects of kidney transplantation. The fellow will work closely with a team of 4 surgeons during their training. Protected time for research is inclusive with the potential of earning a Master's degree for those candidates interested in the 2nd year.
