Questionnaire

1. Were the risks of infertility discussed with you prior to undergoing treatment?
2. What treatment(s) did you undergo (e.g., surgery, chemotherapy, retroperitoneal lymph node dissection, radiation)?
3. At what point(s) during your diagnosis or treatment were you offered the option of sperm cryopreservation?
4. What were your reasons for choosing to bank sperm?
5. Was the sperm banking process straightforward? If not, what challenges did you encounter?
6. What was the total cost of sperm banking, and did you feel this cost was reasonable?
7. Did you feel you had sufficient time to make an informed decision about sperm banking before starting treatment?
8. Did you ultimately use your cryopreserved sperm for assisted reproductive technologies (e.g., intrauterine insemination or in vitro fertilization)?
9. If yes, was the assisted reproductive technology successful in producing offspring?
10. Do you currently have any biologic children, and if so, were they conceived naturally or through ART?
