ACADEMIC UROLOGIC ONCOLOGIST POSITION

The Division of Urology at The Ottawa Hospital and University of Ottawa invites applications for a full-time academic uro-oncologist position. The successful candidate will join a thriving Division caring for the entire spectrum of urologic oncology in a fully integrated clinical, research, and teaching environment in Ottawa, Ontario, Canada.

The position offers the opportunity to work within a highly collaborative division including four urologic oncologists, two oncology fellows, a large residency program, and graduate students. The city of Ottawa and surrounding national capital region provide an outstanding mix of cultural, recreational and educational opportunities. It is an excellent place to raise young families.

The successful applicant is expected to balance clinical activity with education and research contributions.

- **Clinical:** Provide comprehensive surgical and non-surgical management for malignancies of the genitourinary tract. This includes open, laparoscopic, and robotic-assisted surgery. The position encompasses inpatient and ambulatory patient care responsibilities and regional call duties.
- **Research:** Actively participate in the research programs and academic initiatives of the Division, with opportunities for collaborative research within the Ottawa Hospital Research Institute.
- **Education:** Exhibit a strong commitment to surgical education at all levels, including undergraduate medical education, the residency training program, and the uro-oncology fellowship program.

Qualifications: MD degree or equivalent from an approved medical school. Must hold, or be eligible for, certification in Urology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (FRCSC). Completion of a formal fellowship in urologic oncology is required. Proficiency in French, while not mandatory, is a significant strength.
