UROLOGIC ONCOLOGY FELLOWSHIP

University of Ottawa / The Ottawa Hospital 2-Year Fellowship Program

We are currently accepting applications for a 2-year Urologic Oncology Fellowship at the University of Ottawa / The Ottawa Hospital for the 2027-2028 academic year. This fellowship is open to Canadian urology trainees and graduates with a strong interest in academic urologic oncology. The program offers comprehensive exposure to robotic, open, and laparoscopic oncologic surgery within a high-volume tertiary referral centre.

This is a two-year fellowship, with the first year focused on clinical and research training and the second year dedicated to operative experience with graduated responsibility. During the first year, the fellow will participate in outpatient uro-oncology clinics, perioperative oncologic care, and multidisciplinary tumor boards, with protected time for research with the potential of earning a Master's degree for those candidates interested. The second year emphasizes operative training and surgical autonomy under direct supervision of 4 urologic oncologists.

The fellow will have extensive exposure to robotic urologic oncology, including robotic radical prostatectomy, robotic radical nephroureterectomy, and robotic partial nephrectomy. Open surgical experience includes but is not limited to open radical nephrectomy, adrenalectomy, radical cystectomy with urinary diversion including ileal conduits and neobladders, ILND and RPLND. Additional exposure to advanced laparoscopic oncologic procedures is also provided.

The fellowship is embedded in a strong academic environment with regular multidisciplinary cancer conferences, teaching rounds, and opportunities for resident and medical student education. Support for academic productivity and presentation at national and international meetings is provided.

Current PGY 4-5 residents interested in this fellowship program should send a cover letter, curriculum vitae, and three letters of reference.
